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The first thing you need to do is dig out a bunch of supplies to build your management log with (which you already have at hand!). Things you can include: laptop/binder white or colored paper (you choose) Empty ABC dividers for addresses and phone numbers Monthly dividers for seasonal reminders, such as birthdays and when to change the oven filter sheet protectors (not a matte finish if you already have, they are hard to erase) Dry erase the markers in your favorite color Some calendar for your schedule a small notepad pad for compiling lists or post-it notes lightning bag (for stamps, paperclips, pens, and other small items) Once you have materials, you are ready to move two steps! Back to the FLYing Lesson to create a control magazine. Control Journal is your personal guide to listing and tracking your procedures. You can use a laptop, binder, or even a note, it doesn't matter - it just has to work for you. You may even want to split it into two or more books: one that you leave at home, the other that you take with you when shopping, etc. FlyLady uses a laptop with plastic sheet protectors so she can use a dry eraser marker to check the completed items. It also color codes each section and zones so they are easy to find. Make your magazine special for you; think of it as a positive thing. FlyLady has a zipper bag for family photos. She also carries stamps, postage notes, changes, paper clips, money, her credit cards, driver's license, library cards, etc. in her bag. On the back of FlyLady magazine, she has phone numbers for her husband in case of an emergency and a very special poem that her husband read to her. You can't build a management log overnight. It will take some time, and even when you think it's done, you'll find that you can change your procedures once in a while to make them better and more effective. Go slow - build a management log that works for you! These are 15 steps to help you create your own management journal. Work only one at a time; they should not be made in order given. Work on a section that interests you today. If the idea of creating a management log is overwhelming for you, don't worry! FlyLady has built one for FlyBabies that you can buy at FlyShop! Whenever you feel down, overwhelmed, or as you just can't do anything right, turn it over and look at all the wonderful things about you. Personal section It can be a file of happiness for personal achievements, inspiration, compliments, goals and dreams, magazine notations, etc. It can list the places you want to go, the books or music you love, the books you want to read, the books you want to write. Maybe you want to keep special quotes or articles or photos that make you laugh. It's behind you! FlyLady keeps a list of wants (things you would really like as a gift, but you won't buy for yourself). She said he had permission to look at it! Family and friends list ideas for gifts for these special people, their sizes, their favorite colors, and what they collect. FlyLady has a section for each family member: in-laws, friends, and SHEs. She also lists letters of correspondence or thank-you letters she needs to write. And the most important part: Love letters to her best friend, her dearest. FlyLady writes to them when she feels the need to tell him how much she loves him. She then puts them on a pillow or in his daytime. You can also add sections for... Other shopping lists - gifts to buy, books, garden supplies, special items for the house, etc. Special project lists - be sure to include your monthly goals! Calendar Professional, member, volunteer, etc. work - things you can be involved in I've shared everything about my biblical basis and minimalist like-minded people take to the Fly Lady system- you can see the EA playlist! If you haven't checked it yet be sure to start from the beginning and work through the steps they are working on.
